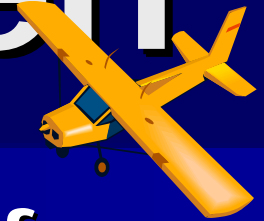

# Worldwide General Aviation

# General Aviation



- 2/3 is not just “around the corner”
- Have to be compliant with core area of Europe
- New generation jets, over 300 order in Europe
- Fills transportation gaps

# ADS-B



- ModeS
  - Decided by the European Community
  - and in the US
- VDL/4
  - Best solution, best bang for the cost
  - Slow Implementation – if any

# What is Needed



- Compatible system with already installed
  - Many aircraft has UAT-units, already prepared for TIS and FIS. (e.g. Garmin 430/530)
- Not a new mandatory system, space not available in cockpit/flight deck.
- Clarification regarding south of Sweden and Copenhagen TMA
